<p>All packaging made of paper and cardboard, but also nonpackaging paper and cardboard, e.g. newspapers, magazines, brochures, catalogues, books, notebooks, envelopes, folders, letter and writing paper, clean household paper, cardboard boxes (folded)</p> <p>DON'T PUT IN</p> <p>plastic-coated paper, soiled paper, beverage cartons, photos, wallpaper</p>	<p>All glass packaging, separated by white and coloured glass, e.g. bottles and jars for food, beverages, cosmetics, medicine</p> <p>DON'T PUT IN</p> <p>light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, energy-saving lamps, glassceramic stovetops, mirrors, window panes, crystalline glass, glassware, crockery, porcelain, vases, windshields</p>	<p>All packaging made of plastics and composites, textile materials, ceramics, polystyrene, wood and biobased materials, e.g.: bottles, cups, films, bags, vacuum packaging, deep-freeze packaging, beverage cartons, blister packaging, disposable dishes</p> <p>DON'T PUT IN</p> <p>Plastic products e.g.: toys, flooring, tubes, flower pots, household articles</p>	<p>All metal packaging, e.g.: beverage cans, tin cans, pet food cans, paint cans, metal tubes, metal lids, lid films, screw caps, small metal parts</p> <p>DON'T PUT IN</p> <p>tools, wires, nails, bicycle parts, car body and motor parts, metal household articles, laundry racks</p>	<p>vegetable scraps, fruit scraps, dry food, solid leftovers, eggshells, cut flowers, potted plants, coffee and tea grounds with paper filter, grass cuttings, leaves and branches, bones, ash, compostable cat litter</p> <p>DON'T PUT IN</p> <p>plastic bags, vacuum cleaner bags, diapers, ashes, cat litter and small animal droppings, liquid leftovers such as soups, sauces, oils, marinades</p>	<p>ashes (cold), flower pots, brushes, CDs, sanitary towels, plastic buckets, mirrors, dishes, window panes, light bulbs, sweepings, small animal droppings, cat litter, tools, bones, leather, soiled paper, toys, vacuum cleaner bags, wallpaper, diapers</p> <p>→Size: must fit in the barrel; everything that is bigger belongs to bulky waste</p> <p>DON'T PUT IN</p> <p>bio-waste, construction waste, batteries, electrical appliances, energy-saving lamps, fluorescent tubes, problematic substances, disposable dishes, packaging materials</p>
